


## ZSL LET'S WORK FOR WILDLIFE









Evolutionary Distinctiveness (ED)

ED is a measure of **value** 



Global Endangerment (GE)
GE measures **urgency** of action

EDGE = In(1+ED)+GE\*In(2)

### **EDGE Fellowships**


Protect EDGE species by building conservation capacity in-country

- 2-year project on top-priority EDGE species
- £10,000 grant
- Training courses, support & mentoring
- Produce **survival blueprint** for their species
